Role Description

Key Responsibilities

- To recruit GP Trainees to join the Dr. Me Project.
- To arrange for Dr. Me to visit local primary schools, with a focus on widening participation.
- To ensure audit and feedback data has been collected by the end of the session.
- To collect feedback from GP Trainees.
- To feedback any comments, concerns or queries about the project to the Dr. Me National Lead.

Time Commitment

- 1.5 hours delivering the GP VTS Training Course.
- 2 hours per school session (1 hour set-up and pack down, 1 hour session delivery).
- 1 hour administrative time per cycle (recruiting trainees, arranging schools etc)
